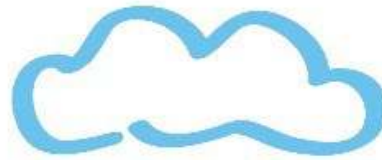

The inspiration for this project came from the record breaking Dave Alley (Race around Australia 2) and his super marathon effort to raise funds for the White Cloud Foundation.

Perceiving a need to bring awareness of the statistics of youth depression and suicide, we decided this may be a way to do so.

We are launching the "BOOTS FOR BOYS" decorated boot (shoe) Competition. Boots can be decorated in any manner to represent all walks of life and situations. (Painted, glued on or any type of art or craft) Army boots, Football boots, Gumboots, Ugg boots, Farmers boots, Sports boots. This is an opportunity for anyone to recognise how depression or anxiety has impacted on their lives or someone close to them.

We are also collecting boots donated by celebrities and have decorated them ourselves. We have Dave Alleys runners and Adam Gilchrist and several others are in the pipeline.

There is a \$10 entry fee for the competition. Boots will become the property of Quota International of Alstonville Wollongbar (or other participating Quota Clubs) to display, sell or auction. All funds raised through this competition will be given to the White Cloud Foundation for their projects.

Finalists in the competition will compete for cash prizes and be judged in July 2016 and exhibited at the Alstonville Quota Craft and Garden Fair August 27-28 .
